Kiai As'ad Syamsul Arifin was the founder of NU (an Islamic organization in Indonesia, also the largest Islamic organization in the world) and was bestowed the title of national hero by President Joko Widodo.

Discussions on Kiai As'ad always involve the topics of Khittah 1926¹ and the imposition of Pancasila as the sole foundational ideology during the New Order era. In the 1980s, NU experienced a decline in authority since a large portion of the member was preoccupied with national politics.

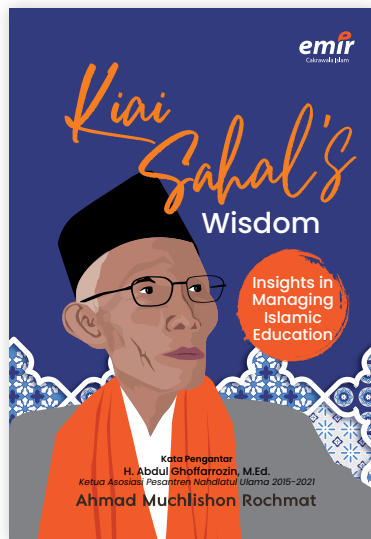
To address this problem, Kiai As'ad then gathered other influential kiai members to hold the NU National Assembly of Religious Scholars. Held in Situbondo in 1984, the assembly came to significant decisions, including NU's obligation to return to the principles of Khittah 1926, which led to the withdrawal of Islamic social organization from the national politics. With this decision, NU could focus on addressing the improvement of the community and the people, such as empowering, developing, and educating every element of society—tasks that were neglected when NU entered the realm of national politics.

This book presents the views of Kiai As'ad Syamsul Arifin who stated from the beginning that the values of Pancasila are not in conflict with the basic principles of Islam. Thus, there are no need for Islamic organizations to feel reluctant in adopting the values and ideologies of Pancasila, which are mainly regarded as secular, for their organizations. This stance of commutuality was taken by Kiai As'ad Syamsul Arifin due to his observation that the New Order regime under Soeharto's rule appeared to be repressive towards the people.

¹ NU Guidelines of 1926, which was drafted on the year NU was established. It provides an outline of the values and ideologies closely held by NU as a socio-religious faction. This concept became rallying point in the early 1980s, when most scholars argued that NU had become too involved in political affairs and demanded that they 'return' to their original identity as stated in the 1926 Guidelines.

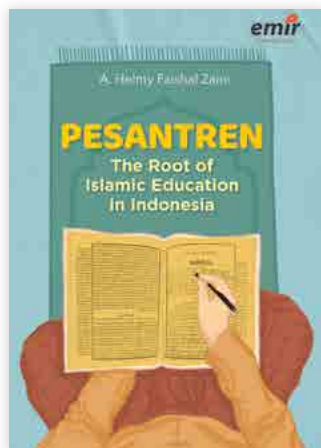
